David Shindle

David Shindle has more than 18 years of professional field experience involving the survey, capture, and handling of endangered cat species in sub-tropical regions. David is currently a Senior Biologist with the Conservancy of Southwest Florida's Environmental Science Division and has served in this capacity since 2005. David's responsibilities include providing scientific expertise on and developing research and monitoring projects for imperiled mammals of southwest Florida with emphasis on the Florida panther and Everglades mink. From 1998-2005, David served as the lead field biologist responsible for coordinating Florida panther captures and field surveys for the FWC Panther Team. As the FWC Panther Capture Team Leader, David was responsible for independently conducting field research and monitoring associated with the Florida Panther Genetic Restoration and Management Project in addition to designing and implementing other panther field research and monitoring studies under the direction of FWC's Florida Panther Team Leader. As a Graduate Student and Research Associate from 1993-1998, David conducted field research in southern Texas and northeastern Mexico on the endangered ocelot for the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute's Feline Research Center at Texas A&M University-Kingsville. David began his wildlife research career in 1992 assisting the Hawaii Research Group of the USFWS's Patuxent Wildlife Research Center with studies of factors limiting the distribution and abundance of endangered Hawaiian forest birds on the Big Island of Hawaii. David received his B.S. in Wildlife and Fisheries Sciences from Texas A&M University in 1992 and his M.S. in Range and Wildlife Management from Texas A&M University-Kingsville in 1995.

About the Presentation: David will present an overview of the historic and current status of the Florida panther population in southwest Florida. Photographs from David's field research will be used to illustrate both the ongoing research and monitoring efforts employed to maintain the current panther population and discuss the current perils that still threaten the overall recovery of the species.
